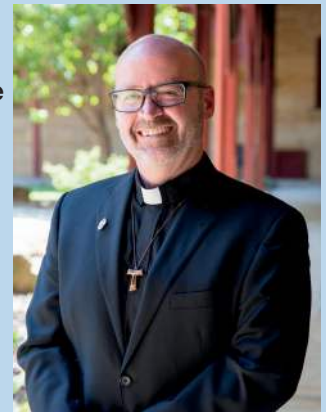


WELCOME TO OUR NEW SEMINARIAN: JIM SOUTHARD

I grew up in southern California as the youngest of four kids, but I have lived in Tulsa for about 20 years now. My love of weather brought me to Oklahoma, and after I got a degree in meteorology from OU, I found a job in Tulsa. I've loved the city and the area, and I've been here ever since. After spending most of my youth and young adulthood as an unchurched, agnostic "none," I found my way into the Catholic Church in 2014 at the Church of the Madalene.

God went to a lot of trouble to get my attention and bring me into his Church. Why would he do that? Did he have some particular mission in mind for me? What was his plan for my life? I wrestled with this question, but with help from my pastors and some very holy deacons and lay friends I found the courage to ask the Church for help in my discernment. Our Vocation Directors have accompanied me from the beginning and given me so much encouragement and hope. I'm kind of a living proof that God writes straight with crooked lines, and that God uses everything; nothing is wasted. I am so grateful that Bishop Konderla took a chance on me.

And now here I am, just finished with my 5th year in seminary. That's year 5, out of 6. We're getting close! Lord willing, I will be ordained as a deacon in December, and I will begin my ordained ministry here at St. Mary's in January, leading to my ordination as a priest in summer of 2027. I'm so excited for this chance to be here with you this summer and I can't wait to meet you and to learn your stories of how God is working in our lives, our families, and our parish community!
