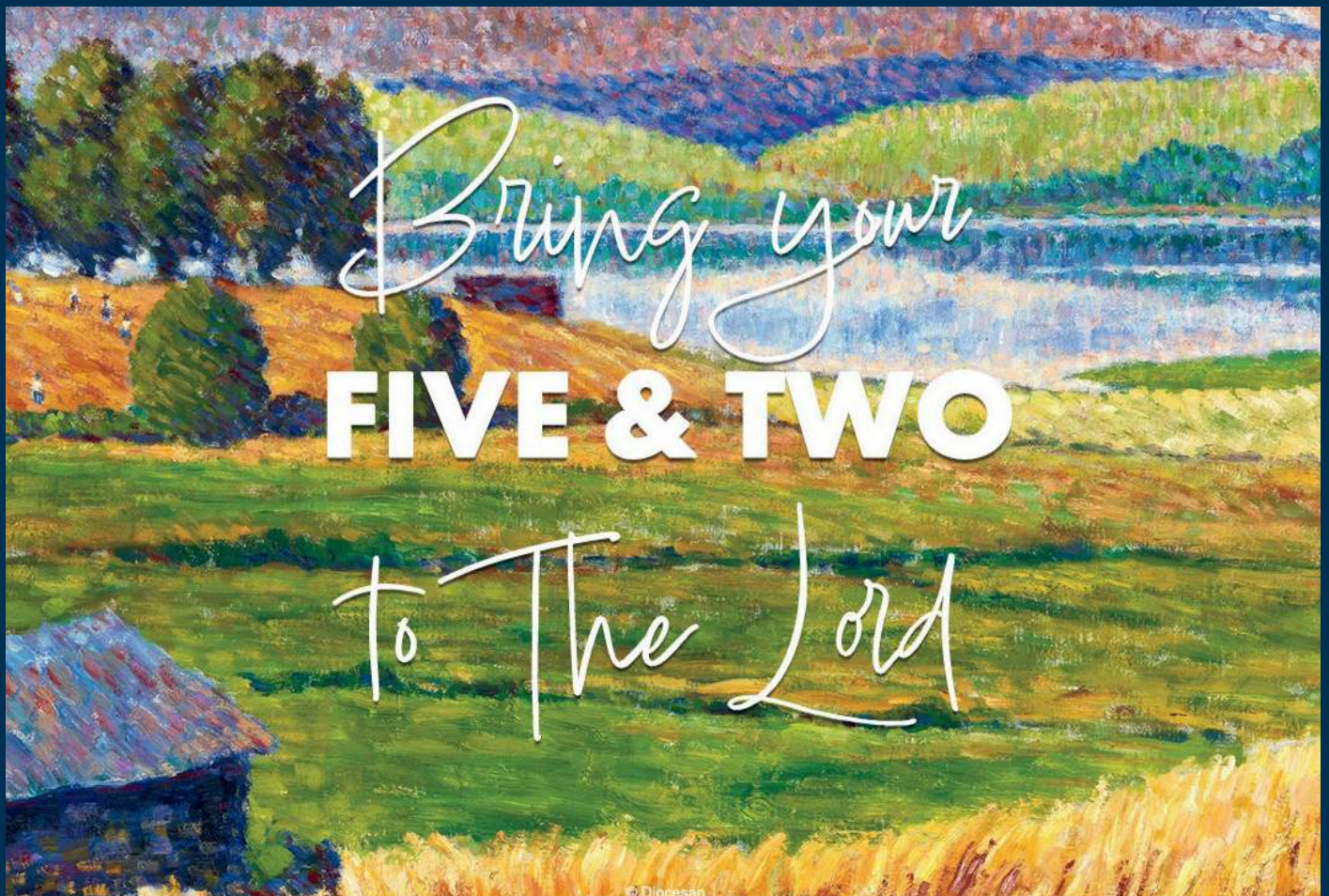

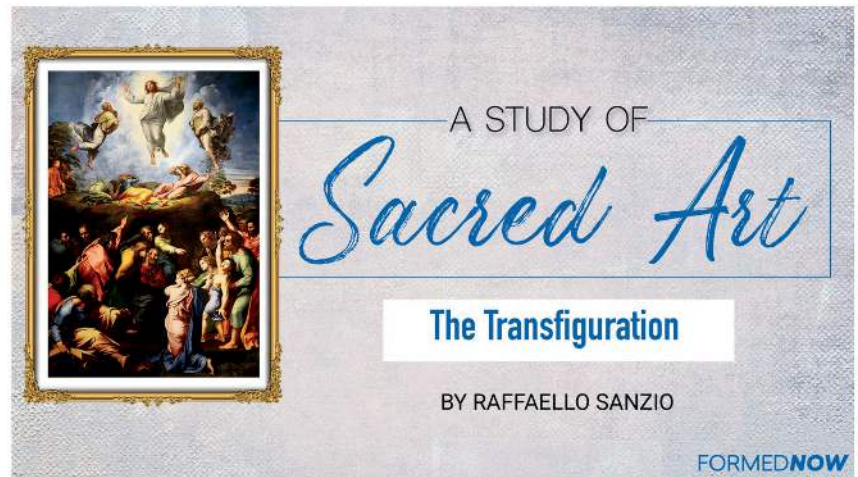
Encore will begin to host Tai Chi sessions. If you would like to learn more, there will be an information session at 11:15 on Tuesday, August 4th in the parish hall.
